

IV National and International Week against the Apartheid Wall

As the ghetto walls close around our people, the voice of the Palestinian and Arab resistance continues to echo within the Bantustans and beyond. Like every year since bulldozers started to level our land for the Wall's path, the Week against the Apartheid Wall (November 9-16) will unite Palestinian communities struggling against the land grab and expulsion in mass protests.

Under the rubble of our homes, on the fields still bearing fruit behind the wall, within the besieged villages and the ailing city of Jerusalem, Palestinian existence has been transformed into an act of daily resistance.

The Apartheid Wall has become the cornerstone for the Zionist project to implement the "Convergence" and "Disengagement" plan to control all of Palestine. The wall should have crowned 59 years of conquest of our land and expulsion of our people. Leaving us within 4 disparate Bantustans in the West Bank and Gaza dependent upon international aid, the Zionist regime set out to put its final borders, from the river to the sea. Refugees were to be cancelled from the agenda.

Yet, the Apartheid Wall has not brought the Occupation any step closer to its ultimate aim of subduing the Palestinian people, and erasing our history, identity and struggle from the maps of this world. It is instead an enormous monument to Zionist racism, a colonial edifice that engages Palestinians and a desperate attempt to drive us from our lands.

The brutality of the war against Gaza is the failed attempt of the Occupation to preserve the imprisonment of Gazans and the almost one million refugees as a "model" for the West Bank and a renewed "peace process" dispossessing our people. The massacres and whole scale destruction of Lebanon – carried out to support the realization of a New Middle East in the claws of US-Zionist elites - has only served to strengthen the resolve of the people to stand up against the escalation of racist colonialism.

Palestinians, as much as their neighbors, have continued to defy the fate Apartheid Israel and its backers plan. The western imposed elections turned into a democratic vote for liberation and self-determination. The starvation policies of the Occupation and the international community have brought economic hardship to thousands of families, yet it hasn't led to the anticipated civil war. The farmers still persist in finding ways to reach their lands and cultivate. The villages, besieged completely by the Wall and the Zionist settler infrastructure, are still alive.

The Occupation has recently announced that the "Convergence" that would have completed our ghettoization was currently unviable. Palestinian and Arab steadfastness has shaken the plans of the Occupation and world leaders.
