To the people of Palestinian,

Despite the geographical distance and the difference between our language and culture, we Mexicans, are aware of the difficult situation that your people have been living during the last decades.

Palestinians have shown their support for our struggles and recently we have received letters from organizations and people giving support for the women political prisoners of Atenco during 2006. In addition, Palestinians have shown their support to the social movement in Oaxaca during 2006 and more recently Palestinians have been pronounced against the construction of the wall that the US government is building along the Mexican and US border. We thank you for all of your support and solidarity with us. Now, we would like to give our support to the Palestinian people.

We know that in the past year, Palestinians chose their leaders through a democratic process. However, the Imperialist Team supported by the UN made pressure obliging Palestine to form a government that was opposite from the leaders that they had democratically elected. Since that time of the Imperialist pressure imposed on the Palestinians, we know that Israel has closed its border with Palestine and does not allow food supplies to enter Palestinian territory. These are tragic realities that we stand firmly against.

With the US government being discontent, along with Israel and the UN, Palestinians who live in the Gaza Strip have been suffering from intense bombing by the Israeli army for days. Israel has offered the excuse that their attacks are in response to the rocket shots fired into their territory, which according to them were shot from the Gaza strip. The Israeli army's non-limited attack has produced more than 100 deaths many children among them and more than 300 Palestinians injured. This is the information we have at the moment but we are sure it will increase by the time you get this letter.

We stand strongly against the economical embargo that Palestine is going through. We stand strongly against Israel closing the borders in order to block the humanitarian help for Palestine. We stand strongly against the illegal occupation of Israel in the Historical Palestine land. We stand strongly against the bombing that is taking place in the Gaza Strip. We stand strongly against the building of the wall in Palestinian territory. We stand strongly against and are sorry for the lack of seriousness with what the UN and the nations have taken the situation in Palestine.

We know that a letter of support will not solve the condition that you live in and neither will it stop the bombing or bring back the people who have been killed unjustly. We only want you to know that you are not alone and that we are well aware of the tragic events that are happening in your land. We share with you the anger and sadness that these injustices produce and we call out the US government, Israel and the UN to account for their injustices that have occurred and continue to take place in both of our lands.

We share a similar pain with you because in our country we have also suffered persecutions against our land, language, culture and traditions which have been and continue to be stolen and taken away from us. For these reasons, we can come to no other conclusion other than that they have been trying to annihilate us, just as Israel is doing with you.

Here from our trench, we do not give up, we keep our struggle, we keep fighting for bring justice to those who have been denied from it, to get recognition from those who till now have been forgotten. From our trenches and struggles we join your struggle.
